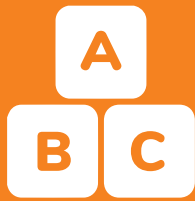


Elementary, Middle & High School

In alignment with our standards for biblical worldview shaping and excellence, all our materials have been written according to biblical worldview foundations and incorporate research on best practices in teaching. Phonics

BJU Press's systematic and explicit phonics instruction equips students to comprehend text and become fluent readers, as well as readers of the Bible. Phonics instruction includes phonemic awareness strategies as well as phonics practice using phonics stories and characters, phonics songs, rhyming songs, read-alouds, and multisensory activities that combine letters and sounds into real words. Word families provide the basis for phonics instruction, correlating phonics with reading and spelling instruction as well as writing and grammar. Phonics instruction covers short and long vowels, consonant blends, digraphs, *r*-influenced vowels, special vowel sounds, silent consonants, suffixes, and syllable division.

Vision
